Thanks to the EU co-funded Justice without Litigation project, the notariats of Central Europe are now moving even closer together in mutual collegial legal assistance. In Austria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Hungary and the Slovak Republic, there is the legal particularity that notaries perform judicial functions, especially in succession matters, for example as court commissioners. Against the background of EU law, especially the EU Succession Regulation, practice-oriented mutual cross-border legal assistance is steadily gaining importance.

For better case handling and cooperation in cross-border successions, a specialised mechanism for online cooperation for notaries acting in court function has now been set-up by expanding the ENN (European Notarial Network) of CNUE (Conseil des Notariats de l'Union européenne). This facilitates direct communication between notaries performing such court functions in Europe.
